The Funeral Consumers Alliance of Eastern Massachusetts (The Memorial Society, Inc.) is a non-profit education and advocacy organization founded in 1962. We provide our members with information about laws and practices pertaining to death, burial, cremation, anatomical gifts and related issues.
