The total cost of this arrangement, if priced separately, would be \$5,235. It is offered here as a package, and no adjustment will be made for items not used. <i>This package is only available to those families who purchase a casket from Keokane Funeral Service. The charge does not include merchandise, cemetery or crematory fees, nor any additional items you may choose.</i></p>

## Services

---

**Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and Overhead** .....\$2,095

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in these charges are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

**Embalming**.....\$545

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a memorial service, direct cremation or immediate burial.

**Other Preparation** .....\$295

Includes restoration, cosmetology, dressing and placement of the deceased in the casket. Washing and disinfection when no embalming.

## Facilities

---

**Use of Facilities and Staff for Viewing/Visitation**.....\$445

Our services include set-up of visitation area, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements & photos, supervision of and attendance during the visitation. (charge per day)

**Use of Facilities and Staff for Funeral Ceremony**.....\$445

Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangements, supervision of funeral, and staff to attend funeral ceremony.

**Use of Equipment and Staff for Church or Off-Premise Service**.....\$595

Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangements, supervision of funeral, and staff to attend funeral ceremony. Includes 4 parking attendants/pallbearers. Circumstances may require more at added cost.

**Use of Facilities and Staff for Memorial Service**.....\$445  
 Our services include coordinating the memorial service, supervision of memorial service, and staff to attend the service.

**Use of Equipment and Staff for Graveside Service**.....\$310  
 Our services include accompaniment of remains to cemetery, supervision of graveside service, and staff to attend service. Automotive equipment is additional.

**Cash Advance Items**

The following items are often necessary and are part of the total cost of a funeral. They are not Keohane Funeral Service charges. The cost of these items vary according to the desires of the family as to their choice and/or quantity needed. Such items include but are not limited to:

- pallbearers
- cemetery charges
- crematory charges
- medical examiner fee for cremation
- airline transportation
- clergy honorarium
- church offerings and fees
- organist/soloist/other music
- flowers
- certified copies death certificate
- burial permit
- miscellaneous gratuities
- hairdresser or barber
- charges of out of town funeral directors
- tent at cemetery
- bagpiper
- paid death notices
- postage

All of these items require an immediate payment prior to the funeral.

**Forwarding Deceased to Another Funeral Home**

This charge includes transfer of deceased from place of death, necessary services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the deceased.

- B. With casket selected from our funeral home  
(in addition to the cost of the casket).....**\$2,295

**Receiving of Deceased From Another Funeral Home.....**\$1,500

This charge includes temporary shelter of deceased, transportation of remains to cemetery and necessary services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies.

**Immediate Burials.....**\$1,750 to \$2,445

Our charge for an immediate burial without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes removal and shelter of deceased, local transportation to the cemetery, and necessary services of staff and authorizations.

- A. Immediate burial with casket provided by the purchaser.....**\$1,750
- B. Immediate burial with minimum casket (cloth covered).....**\$2,445
- C. Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home  
(in addition to the cost of the casket).....**\$1,750

**Direct Cremation.....**\$1,750 to \$1,875

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes transfer of deceased from place of death, local transportation to crematory, necessary services of staff and authorizations. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard. Crematory fees and cash advance items are additional.

- A. Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser.....**\$1,750
- B. Direct cremation with alternative container.....**\$1,875
- C. Direct cremation with casket selected from our funeral home  
(in addition to cost of casket).....**\$1,750
