GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of April 1, 2005 but are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services listed below are those we can provide to customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF AND OVERHEAD

Our fee for basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

1. Responding to the initial request for service.
2. Arrangement conference with family or responsible party.
3. Preparation of biographical and statistical data.
4. Completion of legal requirements to secure and obtain all necessary permits and authorizations.
5. Staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral.
6. Coordination with those providing other services.
7. Preparation and placement of obituary notices.
8. Retention and care of remains prior to commencement of post death activities.
9. Overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, administrative, equipment and inventory costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

\$ 1400.00**EMBALMING** (Including use of the preparation room)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

CASH ADVANCE ITEMS

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes the local, (within 15 miles) removal of remains to this funeral home, basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, obtaining necessary permits. It does not include a casket or alternative shipping container, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or sheltering for days on which not post death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains to the airport or other destination, or the charges of a common carrier.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes receiving the remains from the other funeral home, the overnight sheltering of the remains, basic services of the funeral director and staff, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and local (within 15 miles) transportation to cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial or cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include transferring the remains from the airport or other source or the charges of a common carrier.

DIRECT CREMATION

This is a stand alone price package. Services or merchandise other than those listed below cannot be added to the charge listed here. If items other than those below are selected, all charges will be itemized individually from this and other price lists provided.

Our charges for direct cremation includes basic services of funeral director and staff, the local (within 15 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, sanitary care and preparation of remains for identification, the overnight sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorization, local transportation to the crematory, the actual cost of the cremation. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post death activities occur.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers this funeral home uses are made of fiberboard materials without an outside covering.

Our charges for immediate burial include basic services of the funeral director and staff, the local (within 15 miles) transfer of remains to the funeral home, the overnight sheltering of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, sanitary care and preparation of remains for identification, and local (within 15 miles) transportation to the cemetery. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave.
